SUBMISSION OF REPORT OF COMMISSION I BY THE REPORTING DELEGATE

Secretary Morgenthau: As indicated by the agenda of this meeting, this Plenary Session will consider the report on the work of Commission I and will also consider the report of the Steering Committee concerning the preparation and publication of the Final Act.

We shall take up at this time the report of Commission I and I request the Reporting Delegate, Mr. Rasminsky of Canada to come to the microphone and present his report.
